<b>Developmental Stage</b>	<b>The Elements of Music - Musical Phrases &amp; Rhythm</b>	<b>Key Word Sign - Auslan</b>
Nursery	Let's feel the beat like dinosaurs stomping on the earth. Let's hear the floating musical phrases, like musical sentences that start and close.	Dinosaur, Roar, Hat, Shoe, Sleeve, Bed, Bird, Yellow, Tree
Toddlers	Let's feel and notice the short and long sounds as we move our bodies faster for the short sounds and slower for the long sounds.	
Kinder 3	Let's identify the short and long sounds in the musical phrases. Learning where musical phrases start: counting the start of a phrase and ending a phrase a class or with a sound/action.	
Kinder 4/ Pre-Prep	Let's identify similarities and differences between the xylophone piece learnt last topic, which used the notes s-m-l (GAE) and this topic. Do you remember the GFEDCCC from Kangaroo last term?  Start to hear and identify the musical phrases, where they begin and end.
